INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE ABSTRACTS & SIGNATURE PAGE

1. All responses may be typed directly into this Word document and saved.

The abstracts should briefly, but thoroughly, summarize the content of your presentation. In 300-500 words, the abstract should tell the reader what problem is studied, what theoretical approach to the problem (if any) was used, what the specific characteristics of the subject sample were (such as gender, age, college vs. non-college, how many, etc.), how the sample was obtained, what the research design entailed, the name and a brief description of the research instruments, and what the results imply (if known) or might imply. The research should be completed prior to the submission of the abstract. At the end skip a line and acknowledge support by grants, companies, etc. **All student presenters should address how their research relates to the conference theme in the abstract and presentation.** Theoretical (no data) proposals are welcome.

2. Faculty mentor/research advisor and the first author must sign this form.
3. Please email the application and abstract to FAMUPsychology@famu.edu. In the subject line, put the first author's last name, initials (e.g. Brown, J. B.): 2012 Imhotep abstract submission form. The abstract applications are due by **March 8th, 2013**.
